

Information for marina users A mobile footbridge

A mobile footbridge now links Saint Briec with the town of Plerin. It has been installed to facilitate pedestrian access between the two banks of the yacht basin, but priority is given to maritime traffic. It is comprised of two fixed shore structures linked to a mobile pontoon that slides to and from the Saint Briec bank. Free passage from pontoon to pontoon is 7m80.

The footbridge is operated by an agent of the Chamber of Commerce and Industry (C.C.I.) and the manager of the “La Passerelle” restaurant, who have been trained in its operating procedures.

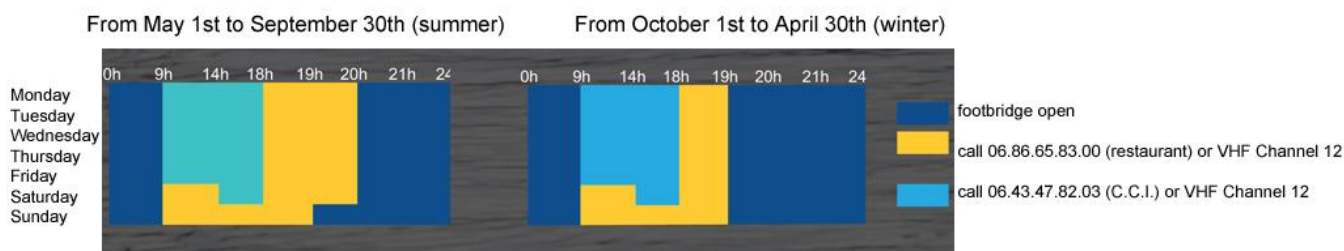
How does the footbridge operate?

A yachtsman wishing to move to or from a berth in the marina upstream from the footbridge should make contact on **VHF Channel 12**, giving a minimum of 10 minutes notice. Other than using VHF, all requests should be made to :

- C.C.I. : 06.43.47.82.03
- “La Passerelle” : 06.86.65.83.00

Footbridge movements will be signalled by a klaxon and a flashing light.

The latter will remain flashing until the footbridge is once again accessible to pedestrians.



Safety Regulations

Passage between the pontoons is signalled by :

- A red cross : footbridge in operation, passage forbidden
- A green arrow: passage authorised, priority to boats moving downstream.

Operating or safety problems

Either of the two telephone numbers given above must be contacted in the event of any operational or safety problems.

In the case of mechanical failure, the pontoon will be operated by hand by trained personnel to the “open to navigation” position until the fault has been rectified.
